Resolution # 47-26

Authorization to Pay the 2026 Audited Vouchers

WHEREAS, the Town of Seneca Town Board must authorize payment of bills within the Town each month;
and

WHEREAS, prior to authorizing, the Town Board will present claim numbers and the amount to be paid for each department; and now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Seneca hereby authorizes payment of the April 2026 bills as presented.

Resolution #48-26

Approve Inter-Municipal Agreement for Road Salt Sharing

WHEREAS, Wayne Finger Lakes BOCES (WFL BOCES) has presented an Inter-Municipal Agreement to the Town of Seneca for sharing Road Salt; and

WHEREAS, WFL BOCES wishes to acquire road salt from the Town of Seneca Highway Department for the Finger Lakes Technical and Career Center site; and

WHEREAS, said agreement will take effect on July 1, 2026 and end on June 30th, 2027; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of Highway Superintendent King to enter into this agreement as we have done in years past; and therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Seneca hereby authorizes the Highway Superintendent to enter into the Road Salt Sharing Inter-Municipal Agreement with WFL BOCES.

Resolution #49-26

Approve Service Quote for Generators

WHEREAS, the Town of Seneca operates water and sewer pump stations requiring properly maintained emergency generators to ensure continuous and reliable operation; and

WHEREAS, the Town solicited quotes for the annual servicing and maintenance of four (4) generators located at the Town's water and sewer pump stations for a one (1) year term; and

WHEREAS, the Town received the following quotes:

- Colacino Industries in the amount of **\$3,657.95**; and
- Penn Power Systems in the amount of **\$3,775.50**; and

WHEREAS, after review of the submitted quotes, the Town Board finds it to be in the best interest of the Town to award the servicing contract to the lowest responsible quote submitted by Colacino Industries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Seneca hereby authorizes the Supervisor to enter into an agreement with Colacino Industries for the servicing and maintenance of four generators at the Town's water and sewer pump stations for a term of one year in the amount of **\$3,657.95**; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Supervisor and any other appropriate Town officials are authorized to execute all necessary documents related thereto.
